**Under this agreement for 2018
Karalee State School will receive**

\$149,150*

This funding will be used to:

- increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B) in Year 3 Numeracy and Reading to 55%
- increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2Bs in Year 5 Numeracy and Reading to 45%
- increase the percentage of students attaining at or above National Minimum Standard in Years 3 and 5 NAPLAN Numeracy and Reading to 100%
- increase the percentage of Years 1 to 6 students achieving at a 'C' standard or above for English, Mathematics and Science in the Semester 2 reporting period to 90%.

Our initiatives include:

- providing professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: mathematics learning area, and providing targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential mathematical concepts and skills in every classroom
- providing focused and intensive teaching targeted at 'C' students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard
- providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- implementing a whole school approach to the teaching of Science and STEM.
