Under this agreement for 2017 Karalee State School will receive

\$141,955*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands in Year 3 Numeracy and Reading to 55%.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands in Year 5 Numeracy and Reading to 45%.
- Increase the percentage of students attaining At or Above National Minimum Standard in Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN Numeracy and Reading to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of Year 1-6 students achieving at a 'C' standard or above for English, Mathematics and Science in the Semester Two reporting period to 90%.

Our initiatives include

- Providing ongoing professional development to teachers in Guided Reading and Writing; including mentoring and coaching opportunities.
- Providing professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: mathematics learning area and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential mathematical concepts and skills in every classroom.
- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.
- Providing focused and intensive teaching targeted at 'C' students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard.
- Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.
