This funding will be used to support the following school improvement priorities:

- **School Culture:** Embed Restorative Positive Educational practices as stated in the Student Code of Conduct and implement Tier 2 PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning).
- **Inclusion:** Review and refine Inclusion Programs, as well as the role of support staff in progressing inclusive practices.
- **Australian Curriculum:** Alignment of teaching and assessment to the Australian Curriculum and focus on case management of marker students to inform next steps in English to improve student outcomes.

Our initiatives include:

- Ongoing implementation of PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning) with an Internal Coach.
- Inclusion support across each year level through Teacher Aide support and implementation of inclusive practices and individualised programs.
- Development of curriculum planning and moderation processes to align English units (teaching and assessment) to the Australian Curriculum and increase % of students achieving a "C" or higher.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Providing collaboration time for year level teachers to plan for alignment of teaching and learning to AC, and moderation of English units to ensure consistency of understanding of achievement standards.	>86% of students receiving a 'C' or better for English (Sem 2 2021 84.4%) > 45% of students receiving an "A" or "B" in English	\$30 000
